4. On the night of the migration, a tribal chief of the disbelievers, Abu Jehl, in a fit of fury headed towards Hazrat Abu Bakr Siddique's (رضى الله تعالى عنه) home. He touched the cloth and thought it was full of gold and jewels. His concern was alternated and he felt relieved to know that Abu Bakr Siddigue (رضى الله تعالى عنه) had left all his wealth at home.

Hazrat Abdullah bin Zubair (رضى الله تعالى عنه) used to say that he had not seen anybody more generous and open hearted than his aunt Hazrat Ayesha and his mother. Hazrat Asma (رضى الله تعالى عنها) was so generous that she sold her inherited garden and gave away all money to the poor and the needy. Nobody ever returned empty-handed from her doorstep.
