Lesson No: 3

TRY AGAIN

Q: What is the lesson taught in the first stanza?

A: The lesson taught in the first stanza is that if at first we don't succeed, we should keep on trying. Failure or success doesn't matter. It's the perseverance and continuous effort that does matter. The poet presents the belief that one who tries consistently achieves success ultimately.

Q: What can we learn from failure?

A: We learn that if we fail, we should persist. We should face the failures manually.

Q: How is failure not a disgrace?

A: Failure provides us an opportunity to improve ourselves and face challenges. It gives us strength to stand on our feet. So, Failure is not a disgrace.

Q: How many times should we try and why?

A: There is no limit for trying again. We should keep on trying till our success. There is no end of glory. Therefore, we should go on trying persistently until we succeed.

Q: What should we do if we find our task hard?

A: If we find our task hard, we should try again. We should be steadfast as well.

Q: Give an example of struggle from your life.

A: Two years ago, I was in 8th class. I had a pressing urge to stand first in the class. But every time I failed to do so. I worked day and night. At last, my efforts bore fruit and I stood first in my class in the annual examination.
